MY KINOM.EDCE OF PADDY KILLER goes back to the 1990s when she first exhibited at Barkfield Museum and was commissioned to produce work for the collection. Kiler's knowledge of Barkfield goes back much further it was her local museum, one she first visited as a child with her father in the 1950s. That connection has always mattered. Halfas is her honerbown. All her family worked in its testile industry; Her grandfather served in its regiment. The years she liked here were formative. This is shern, aged five, her grandmother taught her embroidery. It is where her father encouraged her to paint; the start-point for their train journeys to museum and gilleries across the Liverpool+full comidor. All part of the docustion that her Fabian father installed in her. I remember being small and his giving me a lecture on john Russin. It was such an odd thing? The influence of family segued in terenage years into those of her associates.
